| Sauvignon Blanc 52%, Semillon 48%. This is something like a bright Grave Blanc of Bordeaux made in Livermore. Such a clean and pure expression of the Sauvignon Blanc and Semillion fruits. It is fresh and lifting with floral perfume and ginger aromas, and slight grass and ripe & smooth nectarine flavors. | | | |
| 3. Merlot, Occasio Winery, Livermore Valley | 2018 | 8.00 | 15.00 |
| John Kinny's effort to produce a Merlot that reflects Livermore, a true Bordeaux country, this medium-full bodied red possess dark ruby color; aromas of tobacco, cedar, cassis and rosemary; flavors of black cherry, slight plum and berry. "Gold Medal" _ <i>SF Chronicle Wine Competition</i> | | | |
| ☆☆4. Merlot, Picazo Winery, Livermore Valley | 2004 | 13.50 | 26.00 |
| This well-aged Merlot is perhaps only one of few, if not the best made ever in Livermore's recent history and it competes with the best from Napa Valley.
"This is a pure expression of our vineyard's potential. It is sourced from our Ruby Hill vineyard. The black cherry and vanilla spice blend well together along with rich tannins that linger on forever. This wine holds up to Filet Mignon as well as a chocolate mousse" _ <i>Winemaker Notes</i> | | | |
| 5. Red Blend, McGrail Vineyards "The Dara Knot", Livermore Valley | 2018 | 13.00 | 25.50 |
| Made from primarily Petit Verdot, it is probably the best wine he had ever made, according to McGrail's winemaker Mark Clarin.
"Extremely dark and intense red color. Aromas of Cassis, black cherry, plum, vanilla, and black olives with a hint of spice. Toasty vanilla on the palate with umami flavors, tea leaves, and rose petals. This is the most earthy wine of our Celtic series. The tannins have a little grip to them which leaves us with a mouth-watering finish." _ <i>Winemaker Notes</i> | | | |
| 7. Cabernet Sauvignon, Steven Kent, Livermore Valley | 2019 | 9.50 | 18.00 |
| "This Cabernet Sauvignon features the signature herbal, cassis, and spice aromas typical of the Cab-based wines we make from our home appellation. Highlighted by a depth of dark, rich fruit that extends from the nose through the mid-palate, this wine finely balances the subtle organoleptic and structural elements gained from the finest French oak barrels to create a long, seamless, elegant wine.  “Berger’s Liter bottling of Grüner Veltliner is a perfect foil for the infectious drinkability that this variety is known for but has an extra level of clarity and complexity that is sometimes missing from this category. Fermented entirely in stainless steel from estate grown loess dominated vineyards in the Kremstal.” _ **Winemaker Notes**
19. **Pinot Grigio, Erste + Neue**, Alto Adige, Italy 2022 6.50 12.00
 This is a sophisticated Pinot Grigio with precision and finesse.
 “Plenty of crisp apple and green-bean character here, but also quite a bit more substance and structure than is normal for a regular Alto Adige pinot grigio. Surprisingly long and complex finish. From organically grown grapes with Fair'n Green certification. Drink now. Screw cap.” _ **James Suckling**
- ☆☆22. **Etna Bianco, Tenuta delle Terre Nere**, Sicily, Italy 2022 9.00 17.00
 Carricante, Catarratto, Inzolia, Minnella - from the N. slope of Mt Etna at 600-900meters. 100% Certified Organic. “This shows attractive aromas of citrus and stone fruit with hints of seashell, with stony and ashy undertones. Medium-bodied, tangy and fresh with vivid acidity and a polished mineral backbone to it. Steady and focused with a crunchy finish.” _ **James Suckling**
25. **Sauvignon Blanc, Duckhorn**, Napa Valley 2022 7.50 14.00
 “Aromas of lemon and grapefruit zest, fresh pear and green apple. It’s medium-bodied with crisp acidity. Creamy with a hint of blanched almonds on the finish.” _ **James Suckling**
- ☆☆28. **Rhône White Blends, Saint-Joseph Blanc, Domaine Courbis**, Rhone, France 2021 9.50 18.00
 A blend of Marsanne and Roussanne.
 “I loved the 2021 Saint Joseph Blanc, which has a beautifully balanced, medium-bodied, vibrant profile that's very much in the style of the vintage. Honeyed stone fruits, citrus blossom, spice, and a kiss of minerality all define the bouquet, and it's going to continue to drink brilliantly for at least 3-4 years, and I'd guess keep for upwards of a decade.” _ **Jeb Dunnuck**
32. **Chardonnay “Skeetfield Vineyard”, Easthope**, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand 2017 6.50 12.00
 “The 2017 Skeetfield Vineyard Chardonnay was barrel-fermented in one-year-old puncheon and barrique, without added yeast or sulfur, and underwent full malolactic in the spring following harvest, spending ten months on the lees prior to sulfuring and bottling. It offers subtle aromas of toasted grain, ripe apples and white peaches, plus a hint of honey, and it has a medium-bodied palate and a crisp, elegant finish.” _ **Robert Parker's Wine Advocate**
33. **Chardonnay, Uncle Yu's by Navarro Vineyards**, Mendocino 2021 7.50 14.00
 Medium-bodied and flavored, not oaky, fresh with pear, apple and slight fig flavors.
- ☆35. **Chardonnay, Marsannay Blanc “Le Clos”, René Bouvier**, Côte-d'Or, Burgundy 2019 13.00 25.00
 Almost green color indicates its vigorosity. 40 years old vines are harvested over several days in numerous sorties. Lively & pure with peach, apple, mint, lemon flavors; smooth finish with minerality & truffle impression.
40. **Riesling – Feinherb, Josef Rosch “J.R.”**, Mosel, Germany 2021 6.75 12.75
 Most people hesitate to give German Riesling a try: “I don’t like sweet wines”. But they would fall in love with it after the first sip. It is charming and intriguing rather than cloying because of its intrinsic acidity balance!
 “This vibrant Riesling opens up to wonderful aromas of white peaches, apricots, pears, preserved apple & candied citrus. The fruit notes are accompanied by nuances of mint, nettle and salty minerality. The wine is fresh and juicy with delicate fruit sweetness on the palate, an elegant structure.” _ **Winemaker Notes**
- ☆42. **Riesling Kiedricher Gräfenberg-Spätlese, Robert Weil**, Rheingau, Germany 2006 11.00 21.00
 “Weil’s 2006 Kiedricher Turmberg Riesling Spatlese displays far more clarity, drive, and personality than this year’s generic Spatlese. Pear, apricot, yellow plum, and pineapple are accompanied by lily-like sweet floral and ethereally honeyed botrytis notes in the nose, and saturate the palate with pure fruit and honey. For all of its richness this has elegance and finishes with the salty, chalky mineral expressions one seeks in great Kiedrich Riesling. This beauty is worth cellaring for at least 10-12 years.” (10/2008) _ **Robert Parker's Wine Advocate**
- ☆44. **Riesling Bernkasteler Doctor-Spätlese, Weingüter Wegeler**, Mosel, Germany 2006 10.50 20.00
 The legendary "Bernkasteler Doctor" is the most famous vineyard in Germany! It’s small, about 8.1 acres, south facing & with an extremely steep slope, about 45-60 percent & dark, weathered slate. The story began in 14th-Century prince-bishop Boemund II of Trier drank two bottles of wine from the vineyard and was cured of a terminal illness overnight, hence the name of the plot. This one is powerful yet pure with the nose of almond, coconut, petro & saffron-wax botrytis. On the palate it’s luscious,ripe & creamy with flavors of lemon pie, stone, marmalade.
- ☆☆46. **Muscat, Domaine Weinbach**, Kaysersberg, Alsace 2020 11.00 21.00
 “A delicate and fragile beauty, this very dry and crisp muscat has terrific freshness and energy. Brimming with earl grey tea and just a hint of lapsang suchong tea. With aeration notes of rose water and pink grapefruit emerge. Very clean finish. From biodynamically grown grapes.” _ **James Suckling**

- ☆52. **Gewürztraminer, Domaine Zind-Humbrecht**, Alsace, France 2019 8.00 15.00
 "Bright pale yellow color. Nice presence of complex spicy and peppery aromatics. The palate shows an unexpected structure. Ripe acidity and a strong mineral presences allow for a complex and tight palate."
 _ *From the Winemaker*
- ☆54. **Chenin Blanc, Vouvray - Sec "Domaine du Clos Naudin", Foreau**, Anjou,Loire,France 2017 10.50 20.00
 "When Foreau issues a 'Sec' (and the decision to do so relates entirely to the vintage conditions and the composition of the grapes at harvest), the wine can carry from 1 to 2 grams of residual sugar but never more than 6 grams. Because of the vibrant acidity that accompanies these wines, the sensation one experiences is of drinking a scintillatingly dry wine, although one with considerable body and a honeyed texture." _ *Winemaker Notes*

Rosé Wines by the Glass

Dry & refreshing, they are made with either one of the following methods: soak the skin & juice together for a few days then separate; or separate first, then pour skin juice back into the *freerun* batch to intensify the color & flavors.

- ☆☆58. **Txakolina Rosé, Ameztoi "Rubentis"**, Getariako Txakolina, Spain 2022 6.75 12.75
 The wine of the locals, it is clean and crisp, with a bit of fizziness, and strawberry, watermelon and citrus peel flavors. A great summer time quaffing drink! In the Spanish Euskadi (Basque Country), Ameztoi produces some of most classic and textbook Txakolina and they are consumed like water there. This rare and delicious Rosé is made with Hondarribi Beltza (red grapes), and blended with some Hondarribi Zuri (white wine grapes), both indigenous of the region.
- ☆59. **The Monarch Challenge Rosé, Raen**, North Coast 2022 9.50 18.00
 "The 2022 Monarch Challenge Rosé is a unique, coastal blend coming from RAEN Pinot Noir lots, married with a block of beautiful, old vine Grenache, all hailing from organically farmed vineyards in line with the Monarch Challenge's goal of a cleaner, healthier, more brilliant planet. The wine opens with vibrant aromas of white flowers, lime blossom, candied lemon zest, crushed apricot, and sun-ripened white nectarine. Tones of wild strawberry, stone fruits and damp earth follow. On the palate, the wine is sumptuous, lifted and bright. Flavors of crunchy nectarines, sun-ripened apricot, wet rock and, orange pith are all held together with a bright acidity, racy, zesty citrus blossom, and a long- lasting mineral finish." _ *Winemaker Notes*
60. **Rosé, Blackbird "Arriviste"**, Napa 2022 7.50 14.00
 (Cabernet Sauvignon 76%, Cabernet Franc 14, Merlot 6, Petit Verdot 4)
 "Beautiful blush coral in color, the 2022 Arriviste greets you with a lingering aroma of strawberry, tart cherry, and fresh blueberries with just a touch of under ripe banana. An attack of flavors is dominated by strawberry with just a hint of lactic feel on the tongue leading to the bright acidity we blend for. A perfectly balanced mid-palate teeming with delightful citrus acidity; bright not bitter lemon & naval orange peels hold strong through to the finish." _ *Winemaker Notes*
62. **Gamay Rosé Sparkling, Bugey-Cerdon "La Cueille", Patrick Bottex**, Savoie, France NV 6.75 12.75
 Slightly sparkling, totally original with flavors of strawberries & raspberries, from Savoie high in the French Alps.

- ☆☆64. **Gamay, Chénas "En Rémont, Vignes de 1939", Pascal Aufranc**, Beaujolais, France 2019 6.00 11.00
 This is a pure and charming expression of the Gamay fruit ready to entertain! Chénas is one of eight classified villages, the so called "Cru Beaujolais".
 "Deep ruby robe. The wine seduces with iis rich red fruit fragrance as well as with its iris and dried flower aromas. The attack in the mouth is frank wthiout being aggressive. Elegant and racy with nuances of wood and flowers." _ *Winemaker Notes*
66. **Pinot Noir, Secret Indulgence "Le Dur"**, Sonoma Coast 2019 7.50 14.00
 "This 100% Pinot Noir presents a rich red in the glass. The nose is Burgundian in style, with notes of smoke and leather integrating gracefully with cranberry, dried cherry and plum skin. This Russian River based Pinot Noir greets your palate with pomegranate, tart red fruits, Herbes de Provence and hints of cassis, black cardamom and black tea. This wine has a spreading, full body with a long, lingering finish." _ *Winemaker Notes*
- ☆67. **Pinot Noir, Auteur**, Sonoma Coast 2021 10.50 20.00
 "Dense mojer plum, raspberry, and black cherry seasoned with dark cocoa and spice coalesce with pencil shaving, spice, and black tea. This expressive, coastal Pinot Noir brings a paradoxical linear tannin structure balanced by layered bright red fruits that evolve effortlessly in the glass. - ☆☆69. **Monthelie, Domaine de Montille**, Côte-d'Or, Burgundy 2018 13.50 26.00
"The quality of the reds allowed us to use an important percentage of whole clusters. Gentle vinification, smooth extraction. We are very pleased with the floral bouquet, with nice dark fruits. The tannins are very well integrated, with a delicate touch and texture." _ **Winemaker Notes**
- ☆71. **Chianti Classico DOCG, Castell'in Villa**, Tuscany, Italy 2019 8.50 16.00
"No. 2 pencil, balsamic vinegar and black sesame open the nose, followed by wild strawberry and cherry tomato. Strawberry and cherry take over the palate before a coffee ground finish pointed up by stiff tannins." _ **Wine Enthusiast**
- ☆☆74. **Cabernet Franc, Saumur-Champigny, Francois Xavier Barc "Les Calcaires"**, Loire, France 2020 6.75 12.75
"This wine has an intense red color with purplish reflections, which announces a complex nose of notes of black fruits and spices. The mouth is powerful with coated tannins. The finish is persistent with licorice notes." _ **Winemaker Note**
- ☆76. **Malbec, Catena "Lunlunta, Old Vines"**, Mendoza, Argentina 2018 7.50 14.00

79. **Cabernet Sauvignon "Seely Vineyard", Prima Materia**, Lake County 2019 13.00 25.00
Leave it to former professional chef to bridge the gap between New California minimal-intervention winemaking and unapologetic old school classical. Pietro Buttitta's Prima Materia winery grows 10 acres of estate fruit at 1,500' elevation in between the Mayacamas mountain range and the Mt. Konocti volcano in Lake County without herbicides or pesticides. "This bold, complex and true-to-type wine offers heady tobacco, turned earth and dark-chocolate aromas followed by opulent, concentrated black-cherry, black olive and blueberry flavors, all embraced by moderate, fine-grained tannins that are beautifully integrated. Prima Materia specializes in Italian varietals but this French varietal could be its best wine yet. Cellar Selection." _ **Wine Enthusiast**
- ☆80. **Grenache, Madison Vineyard "Panza"**, Los Carneros 2020 7.50 14.00
"The brilliant ruby red color transcends throughout the glass to bold and confident levels. The essence of strawberry blossoms and Irish breakfast tea tantalize you through a sensual aromatic experience leading your pallet to a thirsting for its perfectly balanced ripeness. Dried cherries and gentle tannins bring a freshness to the wine leaving your tastebuds refreshed and yearning for another sip." _ **Winemaker Notes**
84. **Zinfandel, Ballentine "Estate"**, Napa 2019 7.50 14.00
"We look for flavors of blueberry and raspberry syrup in the Zinfandel grapes to indicate ripeness. When squeezed the berries leave the fingers sticky from all of the sugar. Picking at this ripeness we feel this brings out the blue fruits and floral notes in this wine and leads to great balance overall." _ **Winemaker Notes**
86. **The Prisoner by Orin Swift**, Napa 2021 11.50 22.00
Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, Charbono. Deep ruby color, bouquet of cherries & meatiness, flavors of layers of blueberry, ripe boysenberry, black currants, cracked pepper & spices.
87. **Proprietary Red Blend, Venge Vineyards "Scout's Honor, V"**, Napa 2021 10.00 19.00
76% Zinfandel, 14% Charbono, 8% Petite Sirah, 2% Syrah.
"This wine is full-bodied, concentrated, and gorgeous, with jammy, ripe black fruits, sweet currants, pepper spice, and mouthcoating deliciousness." _ **Winemaker Notes**

Rhône-Like Red Wines of the World - Petite Sirah (Durif)

Durif is a variety of red wine grape primarily grown in California, Australia, France, and Israel. It was cultivated in the early 20th century in areas like Isère and Ardèche in the region of Rhône-Alpes. The grape is named after François Durif, a botanist at the University of Montpellier. It was in a Peloursin vineyard near the university that he discovered the unique vine that he named for himself in 1880. As a conclusion of DNA fingerprinting at the University of California, Davis in 1997, Syrah was identified as the source of the pollen that originally crossed with Peloursin flowers.
